

SUPERVISED PRACTITIONER

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RETAINING OR REQUESTING SUPERVISED PRACTITIONER CERTIFICATION UNDER THE SUPERVISED PRACTICE RULES IF RECEIVED NOTICE THAT THE SUPERVISED PRACTITIONER DID NOT ACHIEVE PASSING SCORE ON THE BAR EXAM

The Minnesota Board of Law Examiners administers the [Supervised Practice Rules](#). The Supervised Practice Rules permit recent graduates to participate in a paid or unpaid capacity in supervised legal employment or placement to provide legal services to clients as a supervised practitioner. If the supervised practitioner receives notice that the supervised practitioner did not achieve a passing score on the bar exam, an additional step must be taken to request or retain certification.

The following steps should be taken:

1. The individual should discuss with their supervising attorney their examination status and confirm continued supervision.
2. The supervised practitioner or potential supervised practitioner should complete the top half of the ["Request for Continued Certification as Supervised Practitioner" form](#).
3. The supervising attorney should complete the bottom half of the form confirming continued supervision.
